

RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE ELECTORAL COLLEGE AND OPPOSING THE
NATIONAL POPULAR VOTE INTERSTATE COMPACT

Whereas, the Electoral College represents the considerate genius of our Founding Fathers as brought forth in the United States Constitution, and

Whereas, the Framers of the Constitution wisely created a balanced representative democracy retaining Majority Rule with protections from Tyranny of the Majority as established by the Electoral College, and

Whereas, the Electoral College was designed to ensure the fair distribution of power in selecting a President without tyranny of one region, and

Whereas, the Electoral College provides an efficient and peaceful transfer of power by protecting the minority and regional interests; and

Whereas, the so-called National Popular Vote Interstate Compact is a threat to our Constitutional Republic, allowing the popular vote in as few as two heavily populated communities determine a Presidential Election and

Whereas, the National Popular Vote Interstate Compact allows a short cut to circumvent the Constitutional requirement of 38 states to amend the Constitution; and


Whereas, the National Popular Vote creates a majority by forcing electors to vote against the votes cast by the constituents of their own state; and

Whereas, the elimination of the Electoral College would encourage presidential candidates to champion the causes of a very small geographic area effectively ignoring most of the states; and


Whereas, under the Electoral College provides for a broad representation of the whole United States;

Therefore, Be It Resolved, that the SUN (Snyder, Union, Northumberland) Area Council of Republican Women, a council of the Pennsylvania Federation of Republican Women supports the Electoral College and opposes the National Popular Vote Interstate Compact urges the legislature to defeat any proposed legislation to enact the NPVIC.
